



WORMS EXPLAINED!

There are 3 types of worms that affect dogs;

- Tape worms – Flat segmented worms that can cause blockages in the gut of your dog, cause irritation at the hind end and weight loss.
- Round worms – Can cause blockages in the gut and weight loss.
- Lung worms – A form of round worm that will invade and breed within the lungs, causes severe damage to the airways, severe weight loss, anaemia, tiredness, changes in behaviour and **CAN BE FATAL**

Treatment/prevention

Adult dogs should be treated every 3 months for worms, the following products are safe and available;

Drontal: A tablet wormer for round and tape worm, WILL NOT TREAT LUNGWORM

Milbemax: A chewable meaty treat tablet wormer for round and tape worm, WILL NOT TREAT LUNGWORM

Advocate: A 'Spot-on' liquid treatment that will kill FLEAS, TICKS, LICE, MITES, ROUNDWORMS AND LUNGWORM, DOES NOT TREAT TAPEWORM

We recommend rotating between Advocate and either Drontal/Milbemax every 3 months, this will ensure both tape and lungworm populations are controlled.
